- Being on a board committee (finance, recruitment, governance, etc)
- Holding an office over the course of your term (probably!)
- Working on ad hoc committees and special projects as needed.

Prepare for meetings by

- Accessing and reading board meeting documents online via Teams.
- Reading and responding to requests for online discussions or board action between meetings.

Monitor and respond to emails promptly. You will be given a Tapestry email address.

- Being an ambassador for Tapestry and the Board.
- Donating to Tapestry according to your ability.
- Supporting the work of Tapestry's staff and volunteers.
