They love the tunes they play, and their repertoire contains literally hundred of tunes from New England, Quebec, Ireland, Appalachia, and a few other places.



Contratopia:

Patrice Pakiz, Tim Reese, Pat O'Loughlin, and Erik Sessions. Honoring the memory of founding member John Goodin by playing many of his original tunes and continuing to write their own tunes. Contratopia musical influence comes from rock, jazz, classical and folk genres. Contratopia has been surprising dancers and listeners with joyous, spontaneous and mostly original music. Based in Minnesota and Iowa, the band has kept a lot of feet dancing in the upper Midwest, on tours around the mid-Atlantic and at dance weekends from Montana to Florida.
